We pray that through all of this that you will be edified (1 Cor 14:26) as we focus wholly on our Triune God and His inspired Word.

We believe that every part of the service should be participatory. By this we mean, we encourage you to sing every song, open your Bibles, read along, and take notes during the sermon, engage in responsive reading, and pray with us.We hope that through this you will grow in the Word and will behold the glory of Christ.

QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION

Read Acts 5:1-16  
Talk about it...

What is your biggest takeaway from Acts 5:1-16?

How does this text show us the Holy Spirit? What do we learn of Him from this text in particular? What has been your understanding of the Holy Spirit in your Christian life? Why do you think there is so much confusion and misunderstanding about the Holy Spirit in the church today? Why is it important to get this doctrine right? How often do you think about/pray to/worship the Holy Spirit specifically? How might your life change if you were more mindful, worshipful, and dependent on the Holy Spirit? Think of how the Holy Spirit is active in the ministry of Jesus and of the Apostles so far in Acts. How did He work in and through them? If this was true in Jesus and the Apostles' ministry, can we do anything without the Spirit leading and working in us?

The Nicene Creed says of the Holy Spirit: "I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets."  
What doctrines of the Spirit can you glean from this?  
What implications can you draw from the confession that the Spirit is to be worshiped together with the Father and the Son?  
How should the confession of the Holy Spirit impact the faith and worship of the church?

If the Holy Spirit is devoted to the purity and holiness of the church, shouldn't we be as well? How can we do that with grace and truth? What if we are not devoted to holiness? What would that mean for the church? Last week in the sermon, it was said that if we are not helping one another grow in holiness then we are not loving our fellow church members aright. Is this true or false? If true, how can we spur one another on to holiness without becoming rigid or legalistic?  
If the Holy Spirit is devoted to your personal growth in Christlikeness, shouldn't we be as well? How can we pursue growth in Christ with intentionality? How can we help one another in this endeavor?  
If the Holy Spirit is devoted to the church's multiplication, shouldn't we be as well? How can we - as individual church members - pursue growth in the church that also depends on the work of the Spirit and not our own strength or intellect?

What is the miracle above all miracles?  
Take some time to marvel together at God's kindness toward you and our church. Share with one another how you have seen the Spirit work and how He has been working in your own heart. Encourage one another; covenant to spur one another on to holiness and Christlikeness with humility and truth.

Take some time to confess and pray together using this text as a guide.
